

Welcome to a charity workshop in beautiful Honeoye Falls New York, featuring many different challenges with some new products from sponsor Olympia Chimney Supply.

Here are the workshop highlights:

-We will show you how to remove flue liner tiles, reline and insulate the damaged block chimney with stainless steel flex system.

-You will learn how to adapt a 6 inch Class A chimney to the new 6 inch flex liner to extend the chimney height 5 extra feet and support to the roof.

-Next we will remove the broken wall thimble and replace with Olympia's new U L listed insulated wall thimble fastened directly to the new flex insulated liner .

-The final steps will be setting the Quadra-Fire freestanding woodstove in place a top a new U L listed hearth pad and connecting stove to wall thimble using 6 inch Ventis black stove pipe.

-We will also be doing some masonry work and setting scaffolding during this workshop.

This workshop will offer a total of 6 CEUs in different categories, it will take place on Friday July 12, 2013 in Honeoye Falls, 15 minutes south of Rochester at 8 am till 4:30 "ish". Camping on Thursday night is available at my house in Avon.
